

Guidelines for Return to In-Person Worship Services

The Midpoint Ministry Center is excited to have in-person services again! However, since we are still in the midst of a pandemic there are certain procedures we need to follow. By participating in our in-person services you are agreeing to adhere to the following procedures:

General guidelines we will follow would include but not be limited to:

As a part of the online registration there will be a screening process (e.g. people showing any cold, flu or COVID-19 symptoms, have been on a plane recently, or live in a communal residential facility) to be filled out for any person who is interested in signing up to attend in person congregational gatherings. You cannot attend services unless you register to come and fill out the questionnaire.

Everyone will have their temperature taken upon entering the building and be told of the distancing guidelines.

Everyone will be required to wear a mask at all times inside the building. Extra masks will be made available.

Sanitation stations will be located throughout the foyer and auditorium for people to sanitize their hands.

Ushers will assist in an orderly dismissal so that there is not a crowd leaving all at once.

Entrance to Building

The ONLY doors for entry and exit will be the ones to the foyer of the auditorium (Doors # 4). No one will be able to use other doors for exiting or entering the building. There will be absolutely NO walking around in other parts of the building except to use the restrooms after which, you should immediately go back to your seat. We will have ushers outside the auditorium to make sure this does not happen.

Seating

We will follow the guideline, "you sit with who you live with." There must be at least 4 empty chairs between people of different households.

Every third row will be available to ensure proper distancing.

Fellowship

There would be no fellowship in the foyer or in the auditorium beforehand and/or during service. People would be ushered to their seats upon entry and stay there for the duration of service (unless to use the restrooms).

Any fellowship will take place outside the building at the individual's discretion.

Communion

Communion will be in individual packets spread out along a table for people to get individually. These packets will be disposed of by the members. Failure to do so will result in no more communion (as a sanitary precaution).

Kids Kingdom Classes

At this moment there would be no Kids Kingdom classes.

While we are taking these precautions, people are still coming to service at their own risk. Midpoint and/or Timothy Christian will be hold accountable for any COVID related events.
